- 1. All MHS rules and regulations are in effect at all times, including, but not limited to, alcohol, tobacco, and illegal substance usage, appropriate conduct and appropriate dress.
- 2. Guests must be at least a freshman and not over the age of 20.
- 3. Guests must present a photo I.D. at the dance and must have it available upon request at all times.
- 4. Any MHS student requesting to bring a guest, who is not a current student at MHS <u>must</u> turn in this form <u>at least 3 days prior</u> to the dance.

Molalla High School Dance Rules

All school rules will be enforced at dances. (See student handbook). Any student who engages in fighting, harassment, or other disruptive behavior shall be immediately dealt with by the administrator on duty. Ticket price will not be refunded if a student is asked to leave the dance.

- All guests must currently attend high school or be under the age of 21 with valid photo ID.
- 2. No guest ticket may be purchased without a Dance Guest Registration Form.
- 3. All students and guests must have valid picture ID to be admitted to the dance.
- 4. Dress Code for all MHS dance events:

Ladies:

- Strapless/spaghetti straps are allowed
- Dress/skirts must be at least mid-thigh in length at all times
- Slits no higher than mid-thigh in length
- Backless to waist is permitted-below the waist is not permitted
- No sheer/see-through dresses and no see-through sides or bare sides
- No excessively low cut dresses, tops or short skirts
- No bare midriffs

Gentlemen:

- Shirts must remain on at all times
- 5. Appropriate physical contact only! Sexually suggestive dancing will not be tolerated. If the behavior looks questionable, it will be stopped. If a second infraction occurs, the couple will be asked to leave the dance.
 - No inappropriate touching
 - No grinding
 - Both feet on the floor
 - No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection)
 - No straddling legs
 - Hands on waists or shoulders only
- 6. The possession, use, sale or distribution of drugs and alcohol on or around school property, at any school-sponsored function either on or off school property, at any time students are going to or from school, including all dances, is prohibited.
- 7. The district seeks to ensure a learning environment, which protect the health, safety and welfare of students and staff. Students may be asked to submit to a breathalyzer test.
- 8. Any bags or purses brought to the dances may be searched and no outside containers may be brought into the dance.
 - 9. Students who have left the building will not be allowed to return to the dance.
- 10. Administrators, security and chaperones at the dance will have the authority to remove any student or guest from school dances for a violation of school or dance rules. An attempt to notify parents will occur if the student is asked to leave.
